Due to the considerable confusion caused by the recent Great East Japan Earthquake that struck Japan on March 11, including the accident at the nuclear power station in Fukushima, I understand you may have some concerns about the feasibility and safety of holding WUWHS2012 in Yokohama.

The huge earthquake and subsequent tsunami caused disastrous damage to the northeastern coastal areas of Japan, which was compounded by the accident at the nuclear power station in Fukushima. However, Tokyo and Yokohama have been fortunate to suffer only minor damage and residents are able to have a normal life, because the power station is situated about 200km away from Tokyo and Yokohama. We have added a link on the WUWHS2012 Congress website that provides official information from the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs concerning the latest updates and status reports about the situation at the power station (please refer to the Congress website: <http://www.wuwhs2012.com/>).

At the current point we are confident that WUWHS2012 can be held in Yokohama in a safe and secure environment. We will be providing detailed information about abstract submission guidelines on our website in the end of July this year. The abstract submission period runs from September 1 to December 20, 2011.

The Scientific Program Committee has already invited overseas investigators to join the scientific program planners (please refer to the Congress website), but if you would like to recommend other delegates as lecturers and panelists, please do not hesitate to mail me or congress secretariat ([wuwhs2012@congre.co.jp](mailto:wuwhs2012@congre.co.jp)).
