

The Finnish Wound Care Society and its active members around Finland have promoted the Stop Pressure Ulcer Day during the whole autumn. We have had and still have information and material about Stop PU Day on the website of Finnish Wound Care Society (FWCS). We have planned, published, printed and shared a Stop PU Day posters in Finnish and in Swedish. It can be printed free of charge from FWCS website. We also have the Stop PU day sticker in Finnish and in Swedish. We have distributed the stickers around Finland in different wound care educational events.

We have published Stop PU Day logos in Haava (Wound) - Journal.

This autumn we have launched a mascot (a sheep) named as Stoppi-Päkä. It has been travelling around Finland advertising the Stop PU Day in educational wound care events.
