CARING FOR SKIN INTEGRITY IN CLINICAL PRACTICE FROM GUIDELINE TO IMPLEMENTATION OF A PROTOCOL

INTRODUCTION

The diagnosis, prevention and treatment of skin integrity issues such as pressure ulcers, incontinence-associated dermatitis (IAD) and skin tears received lots of attention in recent years. Nursing and medical practice, education and research aim to provide patients with the best care. Örebro University aims to develop clinical leaders in quality of care related to pressure ulcer, IAD and skin tear prevention and management. Recent research focused on recommendations for prevention and treatment and on the mutual relationship between these three skin conditions. As often, translating insights from research into practice is very complex. Implementation requires careful analysis and planning.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this one-and-a-half day programme is to coach participants in developing and implementing a protocol for the prevention and treatment of pressure ulcers, IAD and skin tears. Participation will result in a customized protocol that can be implemented easily in the own organization. Theoretical backgrounds are taught to facilitate the development and implementation of the protocol.

OUTLINE AND COACHING

The programme includes 1,5 days of teaching and training. The programme is led by Prof. Dimitri Beeckman, Professor of Skin Integrity and Clinical Nursing at Ghent University (Belgium) and Örebro University (Sweden). The teaching language is English.

PROGRAMME

DAY 1 (27.02.2019, 13:00 – 17:00)

- Participants are coached by an expert to develop a protocol for prevention and treatment of pressure ulcers, IAD and skin tears
- Evidence to support the recommendations in their protocols will be discussed interactively
- Participants are supported in designing and selecting outcome measures to inform policy making



- Participants receive recommendations and best practices to prepare the implementation process in their own organization

DAY 2 (28.02.2019, 09:00 – 17:00)

- Participants present their newly developed prevention and treatment protocols and discuss this with the other participants
- Participants work under guidance on a concrete plan to implement the various protocols in their organization
- Participants develop quality indicators to demonstrate the impact of their protocols in clinical practice

Prof. Dimitri Beeckman is a globally recognized thought leader in the field of skin integrity and clinical nursing. He holds a BSc. in Nursing, an MSc. in Nursing and Midwifery, an MSc. in Education, and a PhD from Ghent University in Belgium. He works as a Professor of Skin Integrity and Clinical Nursing at the University Centre of Nursing and Midwifery at Ghent University in Belgium. He holds visiting appointments at the University of Surrey (Guilford, UK), the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland (Dublin, Ireland), and at Örebro University (Sweden). He is an expert in skin integrity research, clinical trials and instrument development and validation. He authored over 100 scientific publications in international peer-reviewed journals. He presented his research in > 50 countries all over the world. Prof. Beeckman holds Fellowships of Sigma Theta Tau International Honour Society of Nursing and the European Academy of Nursing Science (EANS).
